

TVET UK's new Mexico office will generate commercial opportunities for UK training providers

TVET UK Mexico is a joint venture with Enermex, which offers professional development training programmes for the Mexican oil, gas and renewables industries and helps UK organisations to enter the market.

The in-country team will identify and pursue commercial opportunities for UK training and education providers and suppliers through its well-established links with government, institutions and companies looking to increase business and develop employees through world-class training.

The launch coincides with federal and state governments' plans to boost its economy, attract foreign investment and tackle unemployment by encouraging public-private partnerships to develop skills across a range of industries.

Alan McArthur, Director of TVET UK, says: 'TVET UK has made significant inroads into training and development in Mexico, and we want to bring UK technical and vocational providers with us. This new office will generate opportunity and help UK providers to successfully compete for new business.'

Tania Farrow, Director of Business Services, Enermex says: 'Mexico is crying out for the internationally recognised, industry-relevant technical and business skills training that TVET UK can provide. The TVET UK Mexico office will connect state governments and established and emerging Mexican businesses to British organisations providing worldclass training which will have both a social and economic impact'



The signing was witnessed by Richard Shackleton, First Secretary – Climate Change, Energy and Low Carbon Prosperity, British Embassy Mexico City, who says: 'This launch is not only welcome, but also very timely as the Mexican government is in the

process of formalising its education and skills implementation plans as part of wider national reforms. We introduced TVET UK to Enemex during a ministerial visit two years ago, and are therefore delighted that they have formed TVET UK Mexico and wish them every success.'

The establishment of TVET UK Mexico follows the successful launch of TVET UK offices in Iran, Algeria, Nigeria and Kazakhstan.
